During our worship services, we provide infant and toddler nurseries for children 3 years old and younger. These nurseries are located in the hallway under the auditorium. During the Sunday morning worship service there is also a beginner church for 4 and 5 years olds and a junior church for 1st through 5th grade.



Restrooms are located down the stairwell at the back of the auditorium. An usher will be glad to point you in the right direction or show you where they are on the building map.



An elevator is available to take you to the lower level if you are unable to walk the stairs. An usher will be glad to assist you to the elevator or show you to a handicap accessible restroom.

Biblical, traditional music, sung and played to the Lord by the choir, an orchestra, mixed ensembles, men’s and women’s groups, other instrumentalists and singers, but most importantly by a singing congregation!

You can know beyond any doubt you are saved by realizing three truths and making one decision

Realize that all have sinned—Romans 3:23

“All have sinned and come short of the glory of God”. First, see yourself a sinner. Sin is tragic and vile. It degrades, destroys and separates us from God. **Repent** of your sin and turn to Christ as the solution for that sin. Jesus said, “Except ye repent, ye shall all likewise perish.”

Realize that the penalty for sin is death—Romans 6:23

“For the wages of sin is death” Sin must be judged and the penalty for our sin is eternity in that awful place called Heel.

Realize that Jesus Paid the penalty for your sin—Romans 5:8

“But God commendeth (showed) His love toward us, in that while we were yet sinners, **Christ died for us**”. Though Jesus never sinned, He loved us enough to die on the cross and pay the death penalty for sin. Believe that Jesus died for sins not His own, was buried and rose again. “The chastisement of our peace was upon Him.” Our sins nailed Him there and “...with His stripes we are healed.” “

Believe on the Lord Jesus Christ—Acts 16:31

“Believe on the Lord Jesus Christ and thou shalt be saved”. Eternal life is a free gift that we accept by believing that Jesus died for our sins, was buried, and rose again. “That if thou shalt confess with thy mouth the Lord Jesus, and shalt believe in thy heart that God hath raised Him from the dead, thou shalt be saved”. Believing on Jesus also means that you accept Christ’s forgiveness by faith and receive Him as your Savior. “But as many as received Him, to them gave He the power to become sons of God.”

Will you trust Christ by believing and praying the following?

“Being convinced that I am a sinner and that Christ alone can save me, I NOW accept Jesus Christ as my personal Savior and will, by His help, confess Him before men.”



CHURCH HISTORY

Organized in 1803 on an old Indian campground, Crooked Creek is one of the oldest churches in the area. Visitors come often to the old church site, several hundred yards south of the present structure, where the stone church foundations can still be seen as well as the “dinner on the grounds” tables.

The more adventurous find the old outdoor baptismal pool partially hidden in the undergrowth between the tables and the creek. This interesting reminder of the past had to be hand filled with buckets of water from the creek. One item of historical trivia which surprises most people is that church minutes from 1850 list the names of seventeen slaves who were voting members of the church at that time.
